Global One Health Early Career Scientist (ECaS) Participants' Fund

The Global One Health Early Career Scientists' Fund provides grants to early career scientists from all over the globe who wish to attend the 9th World One Health Congress in Lisbon and engage with distinguished members, speakers and participants over the 4-day event.

If you wish to apply for the Early Career Scientists' (ECaS) Fund, the first step is to indicate in your "User Details" in Conftool that you would like to be invited to apply by ticking the appropriate box.

After the abstract evaluation process, presenting authors of the highest-scoring accepted abstracts (both oral and poster presentations) will be invited to apply for the ECaS Fund. The Fund will be allocated based on the abstract scores, which are assessed by our Scientific Program Committee.

Eligible presenting authors should meet the following criteria:

- you are a senior PhD student (expected to complete your dissertation within a year of the conference) or
- you hold a PhD or a clinical qualification for less than 3 years at the time of the application. Special considerations (e.g. maternity / paternity leave) will be taken into account
- your research focuses on one of the conference's main program topics (either in the Scientific Program or Science Policy Interface track)

How to apply?

- Indicate in your "User Details" in Conftool that you would like to be invited to apply.
- Register and submit an abstract to the 9th World One Health Congress.
- If you are invited to apply to the ECaS fund, you should submit a proof of status (In English on the institution's letterhead from a faculty member or Department Head) and a Statement of Interest by yourself. Both documents should contain the same name and surname as your Conftool registration account and should contain the date of signature.

What does the Early Career Scientists' Fund entail?

- The ECaS Fund covers registration fee, travel or accommodation.

Global One Health Low and Lower-middle Income countries (LMIC) Participants' Fund

The Global One Health LMIC Participants' Fund provides travel and participation grants to delegates employed by or studying at organisations and institutions in low and lower-middle income countries who wish to attend the 9th World One Health Congress in Lisbon and engage with distinguished members, speakers and participants over the 4-day event.

If you wish to apply for the LMIC Fund, the first step is to indicate in your "User Details" in Conftool that you would like to be invited to apply by ticking the appropriate box.

After the abstract evaluation process, presenting authors of the highest scoring accepted abstracts (orals and posters) will be invited to apply for the LMIC Fund. The LMIC Fund will be allocated based on the score of the abstracts, which will be evaluated by our Scientific Program Committee.

Eligible presenting authors should meet the following criteria:

- You study at/or work for an organisation located in a low or lower-middle income country, as defined by the [World Bank list](#).

How to apply?

- Indicate in your "User Details" in Conftool that you would like to be invited to apply.
- Register and submit an abstract to the 9th World One Health Congress.
- If you are invited to apply to the LMIC fund, you should submit a proof of status (In English on the institution's letterhead from a faculty member or Department Head) and a Statement of Interest by yourself. Both documents should contain the same name and surname as your Conftool registration account and should contain the date of signature.

What does the LMIC Fund entail?

- The LMIC Fund covers registration fee, travel or accommodation.

Global One Health Early Career Entrepreneur (ECEP) Participants' Fund

The Global One Health ECEP Participants' Fund provides travel and participation grants to delegates who are early career entrepreneurs and professionals and who are founders or employees of a company of less than 7 years old and between the ages of 20 and 45, with academic or professional backgrounds in public health, veterinary medicine, environmental science, biotechnology, or other related disciplines. The companies must demonstrate that they are working towards the operationalisation of One Health concepts, bringing solutions to address One Health challenges in human, animal, planetary or environmental health. The delegates wish to attend the 9th World One Health Congress in Lisbon and engage with distinguished members, speakers and participants over the 4-day event.

If you wish to apply for the ECEP Fund, the first step is to indicate in your "User Details" in Conftool that you would like to be invited to apply by ticking the appropriate box.

After the abstract evaluation process, presenting authors of the highest scoring accepted abstracts (orals and posters) will be invited to apply for the ECEP Fund. The ECEP Fund will be allocated based on the score of the abstracts, which will be evaluated by our Scientific Program Committee.

Eligible presenting authors should meet the following criteria:

- You are a founder or employee of a company of less than 7 years old and between the ages of 20 and 45, with academic or professional backgrounds in public health, veterinary medicine, environmental science, biotechnology, or other related disciplines. Your company must demonstrate that it is working towards the operationalisation of One Health concepts, bringing solutions to address One Health challenges in human, animal, planetary or environmental health.

How to apply?

- Indicate in your "User Details" in Conftool that you would like to be invited to apply.
- Register and submit an abstract to the 9th World One Health Congress.
- If you are invited to apply to the ECEP fund, you should submit a proof of status (In English on the company's letterhead from a Department Head) and a Statement of Interest by yourself.
